To TCU Students and Parents:

A TCU education represents a major investment for you in both time and money. We want to be certain that you have an opportunity to protect your financial commitment in case of illness or accident. In an effort to minimize any potential financial loss, TCU has arranged with A.W.G. Dewar, Inc. to provide an insurance program (the Tuition Refund Plan) that will provide coverage for tuition costs if medical problems, including mental health issues, require withdrawal from school before a semester ends.

The Tuition Refund Plan (the Plan) is a private insurance plan administered by A.W.G. Dewar that complements and enhances the University's published tuition refund policy. Participation in the Plan represents a contract between the student and A.W.G. Dewar. Students who withdraw due to medical problems are assured, in most cases, of an **80% refund of tuition** throughout the semester even after the University's refund schedule has expired.

**Full-time undergraduate students who are enrolled for 12 hours or more will be automatically enrolled in the Tuition Refund Plan. The charge for the Plan is \$168 per semester and will be included in the first bill of each fall and spring semester.** The Plan does not cover summer sessions.

**Students who do not wish to participate in the Tuition Refund Plan can opt out of the Plan by waiving coverage for the entire academic year through the online Tuition Refund Plan waiver process beginning 24 hours after enrollment for the fall semester. Students simply need to log on to [my.tcu.edu](http://my.tcu.edu) and waive the Tuition Refund Plan under the Student Services tile. The deadline for opting out of the Tuition Refund Plan and waiving coverage is 5:00 P.M. CST on August 23, 2021.** The waiver process for the fall semester covers the spring semester as well, but you may choose to opt back in for the spring semester.

Even though you may choose to waive coverage by opting out of the Plan, we urge you to carefully consider the suitability of the Tuition Refund Plan for your family since **University tuition refunds due to medical withdrawals are not processed by TCU outside of the University's standard refund policy.**

The chart below illustrates how the Tuition Refund Plan supplements TCU's tuition refund schedule for students who completely withdraw from the University due to medical problems, including mental health withdrawals.

If the Withdrawal Occurs		University Refunds	Tuition Refund Plan	Student Receives
On or before	5th Class Day	100%	0%	100%
	10th Class Day	75%	5%	80%
	15th Class Day	50%	30%	80%
	20th Class Day	25%	55%	80%
After the	20th Class Day	0%	80%	80%

NOTES:

1. This plan covers tuition only.
2. A federal aid recipient who withdraws before the 60% point in the enrollment period may have to return a prorated portion of the federal aid he or she received or that TCU received on his or her behalf.
